

## "STANDING BEFORE GOD": THE BIBLICAL EXPERIENCE OF PRAYER

Asher Finkel was born in Jerusalem and educated in the United States and in Europe. He was ordained at Yeshiva University-Theological Seminary and he received his doctorate from Tubingen University in West Germany. Professor Finkel taught at Tubingen, Brown and New York Universities and currently is a full professor in the graduate department of Judeo-Christian Studies at Seton Hall Universtiy. He published a comparative study of the "Pharisees and the Teacher of Nazareth" (Leiden: Bull, rep 1974) and he recently coedited and contributed to a liturgical study of "Standing Before God" (New York: Ktov, 1981). He has contributed to different scholarly journals both here and abroad. He lectures on the early history of Judaism and Christianity and has participated in ecumenical work, including a visiting professorship of Scriptures at Maryknoll School of Theology.
