Rabbi Abraham Joshua Heschel marched with Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. and throughout his life, was involved in civil rights and social justice issues for all people.

Susannah Heschel won the National Jewish Book Award and the 2000 World Union for Progress Judaism Award for her book, "Abraham Geiger and the Jewish Jesus." She has edited seven books and numerous articles related to her areas of expertise: Jewish Feminism and German-Jewish Relations.
