Thirty years ago, a small number of Jews and Catholics met in an upstairs room in downtown Mobile to view a filmstrip called "Christians and Jews - A Troubled Brotherhood." The result was the beginning of what is now known as the Mobile Area Christian-Jewish Dialogue. Although the group began with Roman Catholics and Jews in Mobile and was defined by what was characterized as "Living Room Dialogue," it became clear that after two years, the greater Christian community must be invited to become a part of this experiment.
