November 9, 1938 was a turning point in history for the Jewish people of Eastern Europe. This night clearly indicated a shift from anti-Semitic rhetoric to violent, aggressive anti-Jewish measures.

This night marked the beginning of the Holocaust, culminating in the deaths of over 6,000,000 Jewish men, women and children, and countless other victims of Nazi terrorism.
